IMPORTANT SUMMER FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

You must file a 2012-2013 FAFSA to be eligible for summer financial aid. If you haven't already done so, you may file a FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov using your family's 2011 federal income tax return and W2s and statements (SSI, Welfare, etc.). Be sure you file the 2012-2013 by June 1st for summer awarding.

You must be enrolled at least half-time to be eligible for federal student loans. Half-time for undergraduate students is six (6) credits. Half-time for graduate students is three (3) credits. Half-time enrollment includes Summer One and Summer Two enrollment COMBINED.

Your must remain enrolled at least half-time or your financial aid will be adjusted. For example: If you are an undergraduate student enrolled 3 credits Summer One and 3 credits Summer Two but drop/withdraw your Summer Two course FOR ANY REASON, you will not be considered enrolled half-time. Thus, your loan will be charged back and other financial aid will be adjusted. Please visit the Student Service Center before dropping or withdrawing from classes during Summer 2013.

Summer financial aid may impact your eligibility for 2013-2014 financial aid. Pell grant received in Summer 2013 may reduce your eligibility for Pell grant in Fall 2013 and/or Winter 2014. Loans received in Summer 2012 may significantly impact your eligibility for loans in 2013-2014. Please make an appointment with a Financial Aid Officer for an evaluation of the impact of your Summer 2013 aid on your 2012-2013 financial aid eligibility.

The Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid (OSFA) will make every attempt to award you up to the estimated tuition, fees and books for summer coursework. There are times, however, when this may not be possible as a number of factors determine Summer 2013 financial aid eligibility. You should plan to be responsible for the difference between the estimated cost of attendance and summer financial aid awarded. Summer 2013 tuition, fees and books ESTIMATED* expenses are detailed below:

^{*}This estimate is provided for budgeting purposes ONLY and your actual out of pocket expenses are determined by the actual costs of your tuition, fees and books. **If you plan to Study Abroad**, your estimated expenses will be higher and we will attempt to award you to that estimate.

Students who receive federal student loans in summer will reach their aggregate loan limit more quickly. Undergraduate students may borrow up to \$57,500 total. Graduate students may borrow up to \$138,500 total. You may review the total amount you have borrowed at www.nslds.ed.gov.

You must accept your Summer financial aid on Webadvisor. Your summer financial aid award will be viewable on Webadvisor on or after APRIL 15th and is pending Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) review. SAP review will begin May 3rd and students who are not making SAP will have their Summer 2013 award cancelled and receive email notification that the award has been cancelled.
