# HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Graduation from an accredited high school or successful completion of GED with a score of 52 (2.7)
- Achievement of a 2.7 or better cumulative grade point average in those courses accepted toward admission
- Successful completion of a high school college preparatory program
- Acceptable SAT score of 930+ or ACT score of 18+
- Students may be required to take placement tests prior to an admission decision.

# TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

- College transcripts must show a C (2.0) or better cumulative grade point average
- For students with less than 24 accepted transferable semester hours or 36 quarter hours, an official copy of the high school transcript and/or GED score (52) must be sent to Admissions Data Processing.

# FINANCIAL AID

# FRESHMAN & TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded based on cumulative GPA at the time of admission; you may be eligible if your cumulative GPA is above 2.7.

# PLEASE SUBMIT ALL DOCUMENTS AT LEAST THREE MONTHS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING TERM OF ENTRY.\*

- O Complete your application by typing or printing.
- O Sign and date it under "Compliance Statement."
- A \$25 non-refundable processing fee (check or money order payable to Marygrove College).
- Submit all official high school, GED, and/or college transcripts directly to Admissions Data Processing. Transcripts must be received in a sealed envelope and are not official when marked "Student Copy." High school transcripts are not required if you have earned at least 24 college credit hours.
- O Submit ACT or SAT results (only if they were taken within the last 5 years).
- OReturn the completed application, \$25 processing fee, and the other required information stated above to:
