
#### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed bachelor's degree (minimum) from an accredited college or university.
- Official transcripts of all undergraduate and graduate work completed and which bears notation of all degrees earned.
- Detailed career plan explaining your life/career goals and how this program may assist you in reaching your goals. The career plan must be typed, double spaced in 12 point Times New Roman font. The career plan should also be at least one page and no more than two.
- Complete an interview with the program coordinator for your program.
- Complete probationary hours, if applicable.

#### Financial Aid and Other Pertinent Information
